

Steps to Admission for the Postgraduate Degree|BASEhabitat

Who can apply

- This programme is aimed at built environment professionals (architects, planners, engineers, or similar) with dedication and commitment to social and sustainable architecture and spatial development.

Required level of education

- Graduate Degree or Bachelor's Degree + University Master's Degree. Minimum credit load: 240 ECTS

How to apply

- Send an email to basehabitat.postgrad@ufg.at, expressing your interest in studying the Postgraduate Degree

Including the following documents:

- Motivation letter
- Portfolio (no larger than A3, max. 20 pages, max. 20 mb)
- CV (2-3 pages)

- Current address and contact details including Skype contact
- Photocopy of your passport
- Official copy of your Diploma
- Official copy of your Academic Transcript
- Certificate of English language level (minimum B2, e.g. TOEFL, CELTA no older than two years)

- Recommendation letters (optional)
- Other certificates, diplomas or proof of work experience (optional)

- If you do not yet have your diploma yet, please submit a document from your university certifying your expected date of graduation.

Application Process Deadlines

- 2nd Admission Call:
Application period:
Sept 30 - Oct 22, 2019
Interviews with preselected candidates: Nov 6-7, 2019
Communication of results: Nov 10, 2019

Accepted Students

- Secure a place by paying the deposit of €1.800 (20% of the total fee) via international transfer
- Legalize academic documents, send a scan of your documents to basehabitat.postgrad@ufg.at
Upon arrival in Linz you have to present paper copies of your legalized academic documents.
- Tuition fee: Pay the remaining amount € 7.200 (80% of the total fee) via international transfer within 2 months of your application approval.
